State of Mail Security in 2022: Review mail threats, Discuss screening practices and How to best protect your organization

Will Plummer is the Chief Security Officer for RaySecur. In this role he leads the company's physical security efforts, overseeing a team of EOD professionals, and managing client's threat mitigation efforts. His most exciting work to date was creating a holistic approach to logistical physical security processes that are realistic and repeatable across the spectrum of their clients. ASIS Chicago CPP Study Group UPDATED Dates & Information

Hello Security Professionals,

Registration begins 04/04/2022 for our 2022 ASIS Chicago CPP Study Group. This Virtual Study Group begins Saturday, May 7, 2022 and ends Saturday, June 25, 2022. The CPP Study Group is coordinated and hosted by ASIS Chicago via Zoom.

Below is a description of the Virtual Study Group; and why it's a great opportunity to help you prep for and pass the CPP exam.

Intended Audience: Security professionals planning to take their ASIS CPP (Certified Protection Professional) certification examination within the next 3-6 months.

ASIS Chicago CPP Virtual Study Group (SG) Overview:

- This study group method is a simple and effective exam preparation method.
- Our SG provides attendees the opportunity to participate in an informal and practical learning experience.
- The SG is effective because attendees interact directly with like-minded individuals, who possess security-related experience, knowledge, and expertise.
- Attendees learn how to use the ASIS Possession of Assets (POA) Manual, Standards and Guidelines, and other source materials to prepare for the rigorous, stressful, and challenging examinations.
- Attendees discover new and effective study methods CPP holders have used to prep for and pass their exams.
- Attendees also learn which methods are less effective for passing the CPP exam.

Study Group Method:

- Attendees are assigned a security-related topic or CPP Domain to present during the SG.
- Attendees create and present a 15 minute Powerpoint summary of their assigned topic to fellow attendees.
- Attendees also compose 20 questions and answers from their assigned topic to share with other attendees. (Consider this a "potluck" version of building a test Q&A bank.)
- All questions and answers are pooled together to create a large practice examination with Q&As from all subject matter areas.
- CPP holders may also attend the SG and give presentations and answer questions about their experiences prepping for, and taking their exam.

Anticipated Outcome/Benefits:

- Participating in the SG is like "pre-season football, baseball, or hockey" for test takers. For many it's been a while since they prepped for a serious exam. The SG gradually improves your study habits, concentration skills, and test-taking techniques.
- The SG allows you to network with others who have passed (and failed) their ASIS exam; allowing you to learn from their experiences.

ASIS Chicago CPP Study Group UPDATED Dates & Information



Anticipated Outcome/Benefits:

- ASIS exams are challenging and intense. Few are able to pass without serious preparation.
- ASIS Exam Prep is like prepping to run a marathon. For most runners, it takes six months of prep to run 26 miles and live-- after crossing the finish line.
- This SG offers a similar benefit for those intending to take their test. Using the SG helps you identify your strong and weak areas.
- Participating in the SG gradually and consistently improves your test taking skills and self confidence.
- Taking SG practice tests gives you instant feedback on your progress and prep methods. If your practice test scores are not improving, you need to change your prep methods.
- Also, the more "real-world" practice tests you take before your real exam reduces your test day anxiety. Think of your practice exams as "dress rehearsals" for ASIS Exam Day.
- Attendees who participate in the Virtual Study Group and complete their assigned topics receive copies of all SG materials (power points, practice questions and answers, tips, etc.).
- Attendees also receive an ASIS Certificate of Completion equal to 13 CPEs.

CHAPTER CORNER

LOOK FOR THIS CHANGE TO YOUR ASIS INTERNATIONAL INVOICE WHEN RENEWING OR APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP

ASIS International has made changes to the invoicing language to help distinguish between payment to International Dues and payment for Chapter Dues. Taking effect immediately, the Chapter line on the Invoice will use the word “Affiliation” instead of Membership. Messaging leading up to the renewal/join process will still continue for those members who have outstanding additional dues from their chapter.

The goal of this change is to help members understand that membership requires two payments—one for ASIS International, and one specifically to the Chicago Chapter.

Here’s what it will look like on your invoice:

Question:

Do changes made to my ASIS International Profile automatically update to my Chicago Chapter Profile?

Answer: NO

When an International & Chicago member makes a change to their profile in either system, the changes **do not** carryover. Thus, if you change jobs, change emails, add a certification, etc., you must make those changes in both systems. So, periodically check your International and your Chicago Profile for accuracy and up-to-date information. Your profile is only as good as you keep it current.

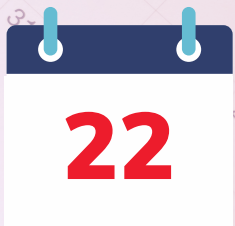

12 Steps to Renewing your ASIS International & Chicago Dues

Go to www.asischicago.net and on the left-hand side of the menu click on Membership.

In the drop down menu, click on "Pay ASIS International Dues."

Type your username and password in the ASIS International website log in page.

You are then directed to "My Personal Account."

Click on Renew, check your information, make corrections and pay your International Dues. You can also choose to enroll in auto-renew to avoid manually enrolling every year.

Success! Look for an automated receipt from ASIS International for paying your INTERNATIONAL dues. But wait – you aren't done yet!

Note: One must pay the International and Chapter Dues Separately. Failure to do so, only renews one of those memberships and not the other.

Then go back to www.asischicago.net and on the left-hand side of the menu click on Membership.

In the drop down menu, click on "Pay Chicago Dues".

Click on the link "Become a Member".

Click on the Pay Local Dues button and hit View the Product and follow the remaining prompts.

Once you have paid your Local Chicago Chapter Dues, you will receive a receipt from the ASIS Chicago Chapter.

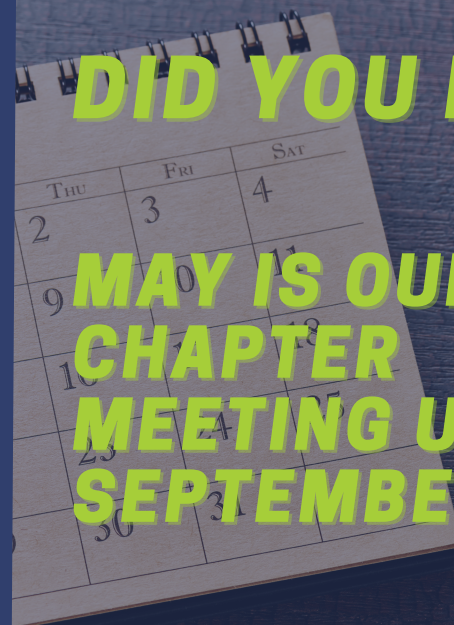
