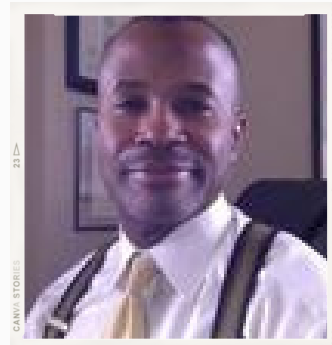

APRIL CHAPTER SPEAKER PALADIN "PJ" JORDAN

On the upcoming ASIS Certifications and the Chicago Chapter Study Group on April 15th at 11:30 am.



This Study Group (SG) offers a great opportunity to help you prep for and pass the CPP, PCI, APP and/or PSP, especially for those planning to take their ASIS certification examination in the next few months.

Paladin "PJ" Jordan, CPP is currently President and CEO of the Paladin Jordan Detective Agency. For the past nine years, he has been helping truth seekers find answers and solutions through his general investigations firm which provides investigation and investigations-related training services. His clients include private citizens, small companies, attorneys, and corporate clients. PJ is licensed as a Private Detective in the state of Illinois with case types which range from family investigations, criminal defense preparation, missing persons, to facilitating family reunions.

Prior to starting his own Private Detective Agency, PJ had an illustrious twenty-nine year career within the Illinois State Police Department and was promoted a total of five times. He held the esteemed positions of Sergeant, Master Sergeant, and retired as an Investigative Commander from the Division of Internal Investigation before retiring in 2008. During his career, PJ patrolled the districts of Springfield, Joliet and Chicago, was involved in crash reconstruction, conducted internal and external investigations as well as worked undercover. The investigations PJ conducted, supervised and directed were across multiple state agencies and including mental health, DCFS, IDOT, and corrections. He also received numerous commendations and awards, including a lifesaving award from the American Heart Association.

PJ holds an Associates degree in Criminal Justice from Joliet Junior College and a Bachelor's Degree in Liberal Arts from Governors State University. He is also a graduate of Northwestern University's School of Police Staff and Command. In 2010, PJ received his Professional Certified Investigator (PCI) and Certified Protection Professional (CPP) from ASIS International. For the past ten years he has coordinated and conducted ten annual Study Groups for Chicago-area members in his role as Certification Chair for ASIS Chicago Chapter.

In his spare time, he serves as an Advisory Board Member and pro bono Investigator for the Lawndale Christian Legal Center and has conducted over 500 threat-assessment investigations for nursing homes within the Chicago area. He was also a volunteer as a non-directive Call Taker for the Crisis Line of Will County for a number of years. PJ is also fluent in Spanish and an avid runner, having completed five Chicago marathons.

- The **Chapter Communications Award** is a new award incorporating and replacing the previous Chapter Website of the Year and Chapter Newsletter of the Year Awards.
