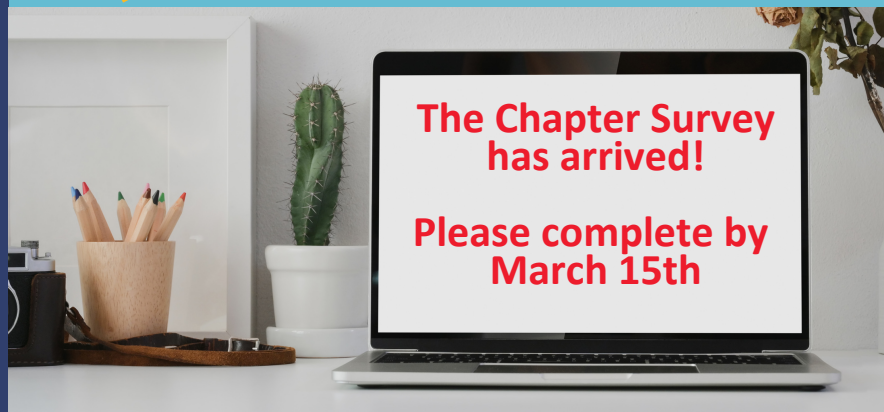

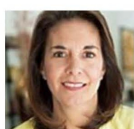

Employers can also post job openings to find their next security professional.

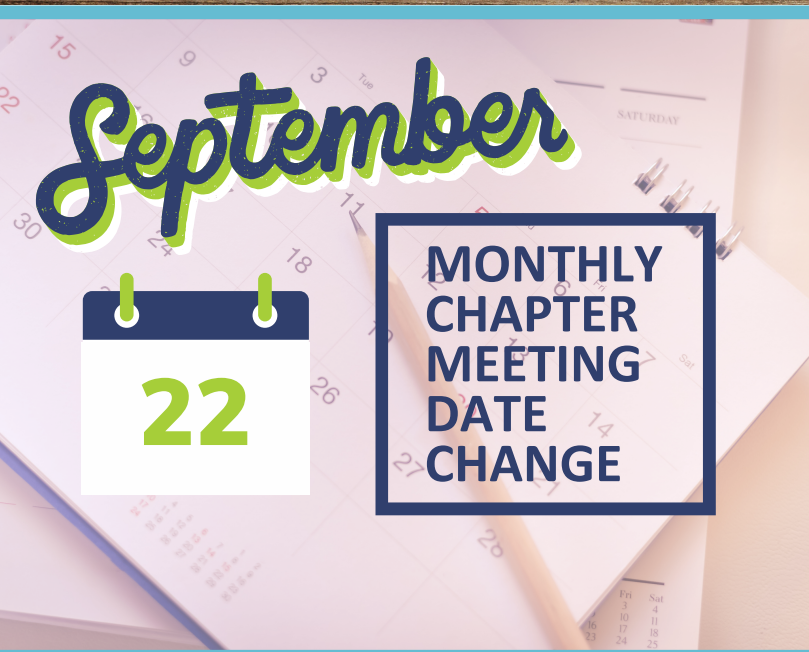

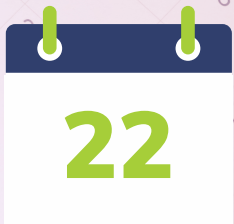

12 Steps to Renewing your ASIS International & Chicago Dues

Go to www.asischicago.net and on the left-hand side of the menu click on Membership.
