## **Safe Chicago: How to Implement a Bleeding Control Program & All-Encompassing Safety Training Program in the Event of an Emergency**

Kaila Lariviere and Matt Ladniak will speak on a new safety initiative launched by the Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC) called Safe Chicago. Safe Chicago's mission is to improve the safety of Chicago and municipal employees by making life-saving equipment readily available as well as offering training on life-saving equipment. One way that this program intends to increase the preparedness of Chicago employees includes installing bleeding control kits at every occupied, City-owned, or leased facility as well as City Sister Agencies' facilities. Life-threatening bleeding emergencies can be the result of falls, penetrating injuries, gunshot wounds, and more.

Kaila Lariviere is a Senior Emergency Management Coordinator for the City of Chicago Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC). She specializes in preparedness planning and is responsible for responding to special events and emergency responses throughout the City. Kaila possesses more than five years of emergency management experience in a variety of capacities at the nonprofit, local, state, and federal levels.

Matthew Ladniak is a Senior Emergency Management Coordinator for the City of Chicago Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC). Matthew specializes in City operations and logistics and also responds to special events and emergency responses throughout the City. Matthew has also been a Firefighter/Paramedic for the Clarendon Hills Fire Department for more than nine years.

## INVOICE CHANGES ASIS INTERNATIONAL

ASIS International has made changes to the invoicing language to help distinguish between payment to **International Dues** and payment for **Chapter Dues**. Taking effect immediately, the Chapter line on the Invoice will use the word "Affiliation" instead of Membership. Why? To help members understand that membership requires two payments—one for ASIS International, and one specifically to the Chicago Chapter.

Here's how the language change will be reflected on your invoice:

## OVERWHELMED BY ALL THE ASIS EMAILS?



We have heard from several Chicago members that they feel inundated and overwhelmed with emails from the Chapter. We as a Board and Chairs, do our best to keep our Chapter communications to a minimum. We send out 1-2 announcements per week for our upcoming events and increase the frequency the week of so that those whose schedules free up at the last minute can attend.

We believe that the root of the “too many emails from ASIS” are from International, specifically, the Community Connections emails. Based on your selected preferences in your International profile of interests/expertise, International will then send those applicable Community emails. However, the notifications can be modified by going into your ASIS International profile and changing your ASIS Connected Community Settings and/or your email & communication preferences as follows:

After logging into ASIS International, click on My Information, select My Account. In the ASIS Links box to the right, click on My Communication Preferences.

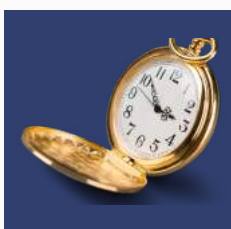
Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on ASIS Connected Community. Click on My Connections to see which ASIS Communities you are enrolled in and to see who you are following. Determine how often you want to receive them – daily or weekly. Make sure to save all of your changes.

Move to the My Community tab and select Email Preferences and verify or change your preferences. Click on save. In this same My Community tab, select Communication Notifications and verify or change your preferences. Make sure to save all of your changes.

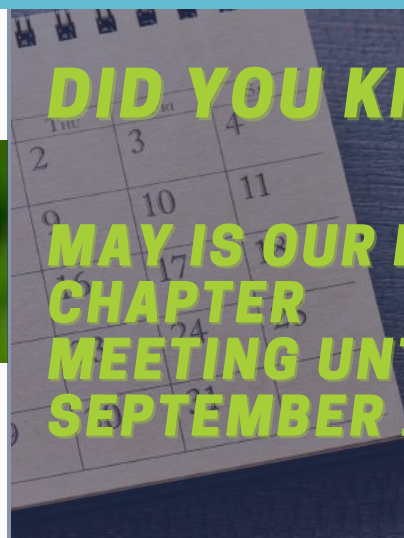

### 12 Steps to Renewing your ASIS International & Chicago Dues

Go to [www.asischicago.net](http://www.asischicago.net) and on the left-hand side of the menu click on Membership.

In the drop down menu, click on "Pay ASIS International Dues."

Type your username and password in the ASIS International website log in page.

You are then directed to "My Personal Account."

Click on Renew, check your information, make corrections and pay your International Dues. You can also choose to enroll in auto-renew to avoid manually enrolling every year.

Success! Look for an automated receipt from ASIS International for paying your INTERNATIONAL dues. But wait – you aren't done yet!

**Note: One must pay the International and Chapter Dues Separately. Failure to do so, only renews one of those memberships and not the other.**

In the drop down menu, click on "Pay Chicago Dues".

Click on the link "Become a Member".

Click on the Pay Local Dues button and hit View the Product and follow the remaining prompts.

## SAFE CHICAGO



**SAFE CHICAGO** is a new public safety program launched by OEMC in partnership with the Chicago Fire Department, Chicago Police Department, and Assets and Information Services.

**MISSION** Safe Chicago's mission is to improve the safety of municipal employees by making life-saving bleeding control equipment and training readily available in the workplace for anyone to use in the event of an emergency.

**THE PROGRAM** Bleeding control kits will be installed at every occupied, City-owned or leased facility and when used can bridge the gap between initial life-threatening injury and EMS arrival. **BLEEDING CONTROL KITS** One wall-mounted kit is designed to treat 8 victims before EMS arrives. Each kit includes a tourniquet, combat gauze, trauma shears, gloves, blanket, marker, and an instruction manual.

Life-threatening bleeding emergencies can be the result of falls, penetrating injuries, gunshot wounds, and more. Knowing how to control bleeding from a serious injury is essential knowledge to keep you and those around you safe.

#### Quick Tips for Controlling Bleeding from a Limb:

1. Call 911, ensure scene safety, don PPE
2. Place tourniquet 2-3 inches above patients bleeding site
3. Tighten tourniquet until the bleeding stops
4. Mark time tourniquet was applied and stay with patient until help arrives
5. NEVER take off a tourniquet once applied
